Note: the rubric and prompts for these essays are different from this year's. Carefully review the 2025 rubric and prompts before writing your response. We are looking forward to reading your unique voice and writing style in your essays. Plagiarism of another's work or using AI assistance will result in disqualification.

Think of a moment when you felt proud of yourself. In 500 words or fewer, describe what steps you took to get there, lessons you learned, and how you will apply them in your future life.
